

THIS WEEK I LEARNED...

This week we learned about the parable of the lost sheep and lost coin from Luke Chapter 15.

MEMORY VERSE: "I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repenteth, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance." *Luke 15:7*

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

What should we do if we've done something wrong?

(say we're sorry to the person and to God)

What happens after the farmer finds the lost sheep?

What happens when we "say sorry" to God?

FAMILY FUN: This week we learned about the parable of the lost sheep. As a family talk more about what it means to repent for our sins (or saying we're sorry for our wrongdoings). Talk about how it feels when we do something wrong and then how it feels when we say we're sorry. Tell your children that they can talk to anything with you, that you love them no matter what. Maybe have a special supper or evening to celebrate your love for them.
